1068	None at Domesday; vested in the Abbot of St. Edmund, Bury St. Edmund.
1345	Inquis p.m. Thomas de Lovayne
1347	heir Sir John Lovayne di ed 3 daughters - Eleanor married Sir William Bouchier
1365	Sir William Bouchier Died
1397	Eleanor died, son William heir
1415	William Bouchier Constable of Tower, London
1420	William Bouchier Governor Dieppe, Province of Ewe, Normandy sole heir, Thomas of Woodstock, Duke of Gloucester 6th son of Edward III — four sons Henry — Manor of Hopton Henry, 2nd Earl of Essex, Viscount Bouchier, Lord Treasurer of England
1452	Knight of the Garter, Privy Councillor, Earl of Ewe, Lord Treasurer
1483	Henry died. Other manors held Shelland, Acton, Mororos Waldingfield, Bildeston, Drinkstone Henry — grandson — son of William. 2nd Earl of Essex
1539	died — killed off horse — to Edward Cockett
1541	died. Anthony Cockett, married Margaret, daughter Sir Arthur Hopton. Sold all estates in Suffolk
1571	Walter Vis. Hereford from Queen Elizabeth I
1575	Sir Drue Drury, Usher Privy Chamber, Queen Elizabeth
1617	Died
1632	Sir Drue Drury Bart, 7th Baronet, son died
